Emergency Training

Port and ship specific training

Regular Emergency Training is a fundamental part of a pilot's competence. Taking effective, timely, and correct reactions to an emergency during pilotage is critical for a safe and successful outcome. Emergency Training aims to coach pilots in making effective decisions, taking the correct emergency steps and responding in a short timeframe. Review and update of these key skills lies at the heart of the profession and is part of the value pilotage adds to industry.

Regular Emergency Training supports pilots and pilotage service providers with the individual and corporate due diligence obligations which are considered good practice in industry.

This high intensity package is delivered via a full bridge mission simulator training/assessment program, which aims to:

- improve emergency response to actual on water emergencies, and
- provide feedback to pilots to focus on continual professional development opportunities.

The course includes dealing with the following emergency situations:

- main propulsion failure
- steering failure
- channel blockage ahead
- recovery of above scenarios with and without tugs
- blackout
- instrument pilotage (during poor visibility)
- considerations immediately before and after groundings/collisions
- legal considerations during emergencies
- any other emergency scenarios likely to be encountered in the pilots' home port.

Course length

2 days with a maximum of 2 pilots using one full mission bridge simulator.

Simulator scenarios are customised for specific pilotage needs.
